RESOLUTION

ON THE PROTECTION OF CHILDREN'S INTERESTS

The Baltic Assembly,

noting the many unresolved legal, moral and material problems in children's protection, that have arisen in the Baltic States during the transition period to the market economy,

recommends the Parliaments and Governments of the Baltic States:

to speed up ratification of the international conventions on the protection of the rights and interests of children;

and to correlate the national laws with them;

to improve the legal protection of children, providing the required attention to their property rights and interests;

to ensure school attendance by all the children of school age;

to employ measures in order to protect minors from any type of violence;

to prepare programmes, providing the opportunities for children to broaden their horizons and develop their abilities during their leisure time, and also to allocate appropriate funds to implement these programmes.
