

RECOMMENDATION

on the Customs Union

The Baltic Assembly,

having studied the progression of fulfilling the preconditions for establishing the Baltic Customs Union and acknowledging the importance of such a union to the economic development of the three Baltic States,

recommends the Baltic Council of Ministers to speed up the preliminary works necessary for establishing the Baltic Customs Union, especially the abolishing of customs restrictions in mutual trade and the unification of customs procedures of the Baltic States.
